As our study draws to a close, we will be celebrating our learning by having our very own Bake Sale on November 5, 2019. The children will be creating flyers and advertising the event. We will be showing off our new baking skills and making cookies and cupcakes. We are really looking forward to this because when we created our own bakery/restaurant in Dramatic Play, we talked about money, menus and how much different things cost. This is really going to be a treat for us and we hope that you will join us to sample our snacks.
